01

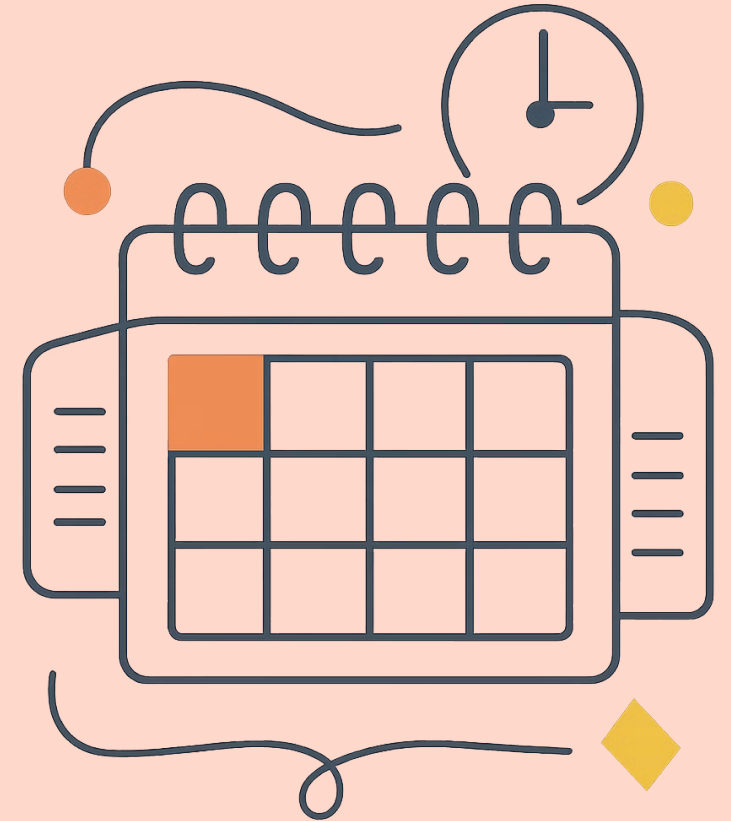
Check my current availability on Preply.

02

Send me a message with the time you'd like to book.

03

Once we confirm the lesson, I'll add it to my calendar and send you a Google Meet invitation to your email or WhatsApp.



Regular schedule (recommended)

Many students prefer having a fixed weekly schedule.

For example:



Every Tuesday at 6:00 PM



Every Monday and Thursday at 7:30 PM

This helps build a consistent learning routine and guarantees your preferred time slot.

Flexible schedule

If your schedule changes often, that's completely fine.

We can arrange lessons individually each week.

I just ask that we plan them a little in advance whenever possible.

Regular schedule

For the best progress, I recommend having lessons:

Once a week

Twice a week

**Three times a week
(intensive)**

Keeping a regular schedule helps you improve much faster.

Rescheduling

Between lessons

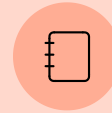
You'll always have access to:
